

1 Introduction and Overview

Cookies are small text files that are sent to or accessed from your web browser or your device's memory. A cookie typically contains the name of the domain (internet location) from which the cookie originated, the "lifetime" of the cookie (i.e. when it expires) and a randomly generated unique number or another identifier. A cookie will allow us to collect information about your device, such as user settings, browsing history and activities conducted while using the Site. By linking the information in these cookies with other customer information that you provide to us, for example, when you log-in to the Site, we may be able to identify the cookie information that relates to you.

Most web browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. You can reset your web browser to refuse cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent, however, certain features of our Site may not work if you delete or disable cookies. Some of our Service Partners may use their own cookies, anonymous identifiers, or other tracking technology in connection with the services they perform on our behalf.

Our Site uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses cookies to analyse use patterns and may collect information about your use of the website, including your IP address. 2 Cookies Affected by, and Cookies Exempt from Regulations

Cookies that require your informed consent are analysis, advertising and affiliation cookies, while technical cookies and those that are necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services expressly requested by the user are exempt.

3 Types of Cookies

3.1 Purpose

- Technical and functional cookies: allow you to navigate through a website, platform or application and the use of different options or services available in it.
- Analysis cookies: allow the cookie Provider to monitor and analyse the behaviour of the users of the websites they are linked to. The information collected by this type of cookie is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform and to carry out browsing profiling, with the purpose of introducing improvements.

3.2 Provider

- Our cookies: are sent to your browser from this site and from where the requested service is provided by the user.
- Third party cookies: are sent to your browser by a third party who processes the collected data.

3.3 Expiration Period

- Session cookies: are a type of cookie designed to collect and store data as long as the user accesses a website.
- Permanent cookies: are a type of cookie where data continues to be stored in the terminal and may be accessed and processed for a period of time defined by the cookie controller, and that can range from a few minutes to several years.
